Saturday, February 16

Medical Emergency, Third St. - Greenfield Township

Greenfield Ambulance was sent to a medical emergency on Third Street in Greenfield Township at 10 a.m. on Saturday. An area person was transported to a local hospital.

Possible Structure Fire, Route 247- Clifford Township

Greenfield Engine and Tanker were requested to assist Clifford Fire and Rescue for a possible structure fire on Route 247 in Clifford Township. Initial reports had the residence filling with smoke but it was found to be an electrical problem and units were returned to service.

Medical Emergency, Pierce Road - Greenfield Township

Greenfield Ambulance was sent to a medical emergency on Pierce Road in Greenfield Township at Noon. An area person was transported to a local hospital.

Automatic Alarm Activation, Wells Road - Greenfield Township

Greenfield Engine, Tanker, and Ambulance along with Clifford Tanker and Ladder, Scott Engine and Tanker, Uniondale Tanker, Mayfield Rescue, and Childs Tanker were dispatched to a fire alarm activation on Wells Road in Greenfield Township at 6:30 p.m. Units were held by Chief Bales, as it was determined to be a false alarm activation due to cooking.

Sunday, February 17

Medical Emergency, Route 247 – Greenfield Township

Greenfield Ambulance was sent to a medical emergency on Route 247 in Greenfield Township at 11 a.m. An area person was transported to a local hospital.

Wednesday, February 20

Medical Emergency, Route 247 – Greenfield Township

Greenfield Ambulance was sent to a medical emergency on Route 247 in Greenfield Township at 11 a.m. on Sunday. An area person was transported to a local hospital.

Thursday, February 21

Structure Fire, Route 247- Greenfield Township

Greenfield Engine, Tanker, and Ambulance along with Clifford Tanker andLadder, Scott Engine andTanker, Uniondale Tanker, Mayfield Rescue, and Childs Tanker were dispatched to a structure fire on Route 247 in Greenfield Township at 3:30 p.m. Greenfield Engine and Tanker arrived to find that the property owner had been burning boxes close to three pine trees that had been ignited. The property owner extinguished the trees prior to our arrival and the engine crew checked the building for extension.

Friday, February 22 -- Snow Storm Blankets the Area

Motor Vehicle Accident, I-81 North – Benton Township

Greenfield Engine and Ambulance was dispatched along with Clifford Rescue and Ambulance to a motor vehicle accident with entrapment on I-81 northbound near mile marker 205 at 4 a.m. The crew from Greenfield Engine performed initial stabilization then joined with the Clifford rescue crew to cut patients out of the vehicle. Clifford and Greenfield ambulances both transported patients to city hospitals.

Motor Vehicle Accident, I-81 North – Lenox Township

Greenfield Engine and Ambulance was dispatched along with Clifford Rescue and Ambulance to a motor vehicle accident with entrapment on I-81 northbound near mile marker 209 at 8 a.m. Greenfield Engine was assigned Traffic Control and Greenfield Ambulance transported a patient to a city hospital.

Motor Vehicle Accident, I-81 North - Lenox Township

Greenfield Engine and Ambulance was dispatched along with Clifford Rescue and Ambulance to a motor vehicle accident with entrapment on I-81 northbound near mile marker 206 at noon. Greenfield Engine was assigned Traffic Control and Greenfield Ambulance stood by on scene to protect our responders.

Motor Vehicle Accident, I-81 North - Lenox Township

Greenfield Engine and Ambulance was dispatched along with Clifford Rescue and Ambulance to a motor vehicle accident with entrapment on I-81 northbound near mile marker 209 at 2 p.m. Greenfield Engine was assigned Traffic Control and Greenfield Ambulance stood by on the scene to protect our responders and obtained patient refusals.

Saturday, February 23 -- Structure Fire, Route 247- Clifford Township

Greenfield Engine, Tanker and Ambulance were dispatched to assist Clifford Fire and Ambulance for a confirmed structure fire (photo below) at 2 a.m. Units arrived on scene to find heavy fire in the attic of the structure. Greenfield Engine's crew assisted the crew from Clifford Ladder with the attack on the structure, Greenfield Tanker handled the water supply to the Ladder, and Greenfield Ambulance assisted Clifford Ambulance with firefighter rehab.
