Sunday, August 27

Monthly Breakfast

Accident I-81 Assist to Clifford Township

Shortly after 1 PM, Greenfield crews responded to an accident on I-81 in Clifford Township. A four-car and one tractor trailer accident brought crews from Greenfield, Clifford, Harford and Scott Townships to the area of mile marker 206 on I-81 north. Accident Assist to City of Scranton

While returning from a Scranton hospital (following the I-81 accident), Greenfield Ambulance crews witnessed a car accident on Mulberry Street in Scranton. Greenfield crews assisted Scranton-area paramedics and provided transport for one patient to the trauma center.

Monday, August 28

Medical Emergency at Newton Lake

Just before 8:30 AM, Greenfield crews responded to a medical emergency at Newton Lake. Greenfield Ambulances transported one patient (injured in a fall) to an area hospital.

Tuesday, August 29

Accident I-81 Assist to Clifford Township

Shortly after 1 PM, Greenfield crews responded to an accident on I-81 in Clifford Township. A single vehicle (pickup) left the roadway and landed at the bottom of the on-ramp at mile marker 206. Wednesday, August 30

Accident I-81 Assist to Clifford Township

Shortly after 3 PM, Greenfield crews responded to an accident on I-81 in Clifford Township. A single vehicle collided with the guardrails. Clifford EMS attended to the occupants, all of whom refused treatment, while Greenfield Engine provided scene protection.

Route 247, Crystal Lake Accident

Shortly after the I-81 accident, Greenfield and Clifford crews responded to a vehicle rollover and sheared pole on Route 247 in Clifford Township with multiple patient injuries. Creamery Road Medical Call

Early evening saw the Greenfield Ambulance responding to a medical emergency on Creamery Road. A male patient was transported to a Scranton hospital assisted by paramedics from Scranton.
