Sunday, September 3

Good Morning - Trees down

Saturday, September 9

**Life Flight Air Ambulance
Comes to Greenfield**

An accident at the motor-cross track on Route 106 brought Life Flight 3 to Greenfield early in the afternoon. Cottage Ambulance is a paid service that provides medical coverage for the motor-cross track in Greenfield. During a practice session on Saturday, one rider was injured. Paramedics from Cottage Ambulance requested a helicopter to transport the injured rider to a trauma center. Greenfield Engine was called to establish a landing zone for the helicopter.

Sunday, September 10

Accident Assist to Clifford Township

Shortly before noon, Greenfield Crews were called to assist Clifford Township with a vehicle accident on Route 374, just before I-81. Friday, September 15

Power Lines Arcing, Decker Road

Greenfield Fire crews were called to the area of Decker and Overlook Roads around 8 PM to investigate power lines arcing. PPL was notified and area properties did not lose power. Crews remained on scene for one-hour awaiting PPL.

Saturday, September 16

Medical Call Hickory Ridge Road

Ambulance crews responded to a medical call for a male patient, approximately 3 AM on Hickory Ridge Road in the Township.
