Accident, Assist to Scott Township

Greenfield Ambulance crews were called to assist Scott Township Fire Company at a late afternoon accident on Green Grove Road in Scott Township. Greenfield assisted on scene and transported one person to an area hospital.

Chemical Spill, Assist to City of Carbondale

Greenfield Fire Crews were dispatched to assist Carbondale Firefighters with a suspected chemical spill on Route 6. When Carbondale Firefighters, Greenfield Fire Chiefs, and Greenfield Hazmat coordinator arrived at the suspected location, nothing was found. Interviews of witness suggest that a propane truck had a brake failure and stopped in the location, possibly with a like-smoke coming from the wheels.
