Sunday, October 22

Accident, Assist to Clifford Township

Greenfield Fire and Ambulance crews were called to assist Clifford Township Fire Company shortly before 10 AM to an accident scene on I-81 in the area of Exit 211. No accident was found.

Structure Fire, Assist to Forest City

Greenfield Fire crews were called to assist Forest City at 9:30 PM, for a working fire on Hudson Street. Greenfield Tanker responded to the fire, while Greenfield Engine was held in station to cover calls of other communities. All units were released shortly before midnight.

Monday, October 23

Training Session, Carbondale

Greenfield Fire crews participated with Carbondale and Clifford Fire Fighters in an intensive firefighter rescue and retrieval training program. This multi-day program is designed to give firefighters the skills needed to rescue trapped firefighters

Wednesday, October 25

False Alarm, Assist to Scott Township

Greenfield fire crews were called to assist Scott Township Fire Company around 2 PM. Scott Township Fire Chief Tratten confirmed that the incident was a detector malfunction and cancelled all responding units.

Training Session, Honesdale

Greenfield fire crews assisted Wayne County EMA at a training session and drill for Emergency Decontamination that was held in Honesdale. Firefighters from around the area assembled at Hose Company 1 on Main Street in Honesdale to learn how to participate in the county-wide decontamination team. Thursday, October 26

False Alarm, Assist to Carbondale City

Greenfield and Clifford fire crews were training with Carbondale Firefighters, in Carbondale, when they were dispatched to assist City Firefighters at an alarm and reported fire in Weis Markets. Flooded Roadway, Hickory Ridge Road

While returning from the Interstate Call, Greenfield Fire Engine investigated a report that a small farm pond went over its banks and flooded Hickory Ridge Road. Greenfield Fire Crews placed warning flares on each side of the flooded area and advised Greenfield EMA Director Dean Cerra of the hazard. The water abated around noon.
