**Tuesday, November 14**

**Medical Alert Alarm, Greenfield Township**

**Structure Fire, Waymart**

Greenfield Fire crews were called to assist Waymart Fire Co. for a working structure fire on Route 296 in Waymart. Greenfield's tanker responded to the scene.

**Flooding Emergencies, Greenfield Township and Clifford**

Greenfield emergency personnel were called to numerous emergencies during the flooding that occurred Thursday evening. Greenfield Crews were called out at approximately 5 PM and finished up at about 11 PM. Crews responded to flooded roadways and basements, and a collapsed bridge in Clifford Township.

**Friday, November 16**

**Structure Fire, Clifford Township**

A morning work session was cut short to respond to assist Clifford Township Fire Co. for a structure fire on Tennessee Gas Road in Clifford Township at approximately 10:30 AM. Clifford Rescue was the first unit to arrive on scene and found the fire was extinguished using a fire extinguisher. The Greenfield engine crew assisted Clifford fire personnel with ventilation and overhaul operations. Units returned to service by noon.
