November 19 - 26, 2006

Tuesday, November 21

Ambulance Assist, Clifford Township

Greenfield ambulance crews were called to assist Clifford ambulance for a medical emergency on Cottrell Road, while Clifford Ambulance was on another call.

Medical Emergency, Spedding Road

Greenfield ambulance crews were called for a medical call on Spedding Road in Greenfield at approximately 10 PM, assisted by Cottage Hose paramedics.

Work Session at Station

Members were involved in a multitude of tasks on Tuesday night. Most of the evening was spent doing preventative maintenance on our equipment.

Wednesday, November 22

Chimney Fire, Second Street

Quick work by firefighters from five communities prevented a chimney fire from destroying a building. Crews from Carbondale, Clifford, Greenfield and Scott Townships, along with Wm. Walker Hose Company from Mayfield responded to a reported structure fire on Second Street in the Township. Firefighters removed some materials from the chimney, ventilated the building and restored services to the buildings at approximately 7:30 PM.

Thursday, November 23

Accident No. 1, I-81 Lenox Township

Shortly before 1 AM, Clifford and Greenfield Townships were dispatched to a reported one-car accident on Interstate 81 at mile marker 207. After an extensive search for the accident, all crews were released.

Accident No. 2, I-81 Lenox Township

Approximately 1:19 AM, while retuning from the earlier wreck, firefighters were dispatched to I-81 at mile marker 206 for a tractor-trailer rollover. Greenfield's Engine arrived first, with Greenfield Chief taking Command. Crews from Clifford, Greenfield and Community Life Support Paramedics evaluated the patients and removed the truck from the roadway.

Accident No. 3, Great Bend

Shortly after being (approx. 3 AM) released from the 207 crash, Greenfield ambulance was dispatched to assist Great Bend Fire Department on I-81 and mile marker 223, for a multi-car accident. While responding, the ambulance was re-assigned to replace Clifford Ambulance at mile marker 06.

Medical Emergency, Shust Road

Greenfield Ambulance crews were called for a medical call on Shust Road in Greenfield shortly after 4 AM. A female was transported to a Scranton hospital Assisted by Cottage Hose Paramedics.

Friday, November 24

Assist to Police, Finch Hill

At 5:15 AM, crews were called to assist Greenfield Police at a disturbance in the Finch Hill area. Crews staged on Route 106, while Greenfield Police assisted by Jermyn and Scott Police and Greenfield Fire Chief investigated. The Ambulance was released shortly before 5:30 PM.
