Weekly Report

February 18 - 24 , 2007

For Greenfield Fire and Ambulance personnel, the Week of February 18 - 24 was an extremely busy one. Personnel not only had to go about their normal daily business, but they saw 15 emergency calls for assistance.

Sunday, February 18

Motor Vehicle Accident, I-81 - Clifford Township

Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were dispatched to assist Clifford Rescue and Ambulance for a motor vehicle accident on I-81 at 6 AM. Greenfield Engine was requested for traffic control and Greenfield Ambulance was returned to service.

Motor Vehicle Accident, I-81 - Clifford Township

Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were dispatched to assist Clifford Rescue and Ambulance for another motor vehicle accident on I-81, near mile marker 211 at approximately 2 PM. Greenfield Engine responded and handled traffic control duties and Greenfield Ambulance transported two patients to city a hospital.

Possible Carbon Monoxide Problem, Pleasant View Drive – Greenfield

A local resident was concerned that there was a problem with his stove and asked to have his residence checked for Carbon Monoxide at 6 PM. Greenfield personnel did a survey of the residence with four gas meters and did not find Carbon Monoxide.

Motor Vehicle Accident, Route 106 - Greenfield

Greenfield Engine and Ambulance along with Clifford Rescue, Ambulance and Cottage Hose Paramedics, were sent out for the third accident of the day, this time near the county line on Route 106 in Greenfield at approximately 7 PM. Greenfield Engine and Clifford Rescue shut down Route 106 for a short time while crews were stabilizing the scene. Greenfield Ambulance and Clifford Ambulance transported patients to the hospital. Motor Vehicle Accident, I-81 - Greenfield

Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were dispatched along with Clifford Rescue, Ambulance, Scott Ambulance and Community Life Support Paramedics for a motor vehicle accident on I-81 near mile marker 203 in Greenfield Township at approximately 2:30 AM. Greenfield Fire Chief arrived to find one car on its roof with multiple patients, one who was ejected from the vehicle. Greenfield Engine handled hazard control, while Clifford Rescue performed traffic control. Greenfield Ambulance, Community Life Support and Scott Ambulance transported patients to city hospitals.
