Week In Review

Monday February 16

Medical Emergency - Miller Road

At 7:00 a.m. Greenfield's ambulance along with Cottage Paramedic responded to a medical emergency on Miller Road in Greenfield Township. One patient was transported to a local hospital with paramedic on board.

Monday February 16

Motor Vehicle Accident Mile Marker 206 Interstate 81

At 9:45 a.m. Greenfield's engine and ambulance responded to assist Station 18 Clifford Township on a motor vehicle accident on Interstate 81, north-bound at mile marker 206 for a vehicle roll over. Arriving on scene, Greenfield's engine provided traffic control for scene safety while Clifford's rescue operated on scene. Greenfield's engine provided patient care and transported one patient to a local hospital. Units operated on scene for one hour.

Wednesday February 18

Station 24 Stand-by per Chief 18 Requests

At 6:30 p.m. Station 24 was requested for stand-by per chief 18 while Clifford and Hartford were trapped on Interstate 81, mile marker 209 north-bound for a tractor trailer roll over. Due to the winter road conditions and the Interstate shutdown, Chief 18 requested Station 24 for all incidents in Clifford Township along with all south-bound incidents from mile marker 202 to mile marker 217 due to Interstate shutdown and all units blocked in. Units were on stand-by for two hours.

Thursday February 19

Motor Vehicle Accident Route 106

At 4:00 p.m. Greenfield's engine along with Scott's ambulance and Clifford's rescue and ambulance responded to a motor vehicle accident in Greenfield on Route 106 for a vehicle off the road into a garage. Due to road conditions, Route 106 was shut down during operations. Patient refused treatment and all units cleared after 30 minutes.

Friday February 20

Medical Emergency Route 247

At 11:00 a.m. Greenfield's ambulance and Cottage paramedic responded to a medical emergency on Route 247 in Greenfield. Greenfield's ambulance along with Cottage Paramedic transported one patient to a local hospital.
