**Week In Review**

**Tuesday, March 3**

**Work session**

Tuesday night work session at station. Tool and equipment inspection completed along with maintenance completed on engine for an air leak involving air line going to the chains for the engine. Also put new tools into service, two new irons and axes.

**Wednesday, March 4**

**False Alarm -- Route 247 in Greenfield Township**

At 12:30 Greenfield's structure box alarm was sounded for an automatic fire alarm in Greenfield Township on Route 247. Chief 24a responded quickly to the scene and found Vector security on scene working on the system. All units were quickly returned to service.

**Thursday, March 5**

**Structure Fire -- City of Carbondale**

At 5:20 p.m. Greenfield's engine responded to assist Carbondale City on a working structure fire on Clidco Drive. While en-route, Chief 51 requested Greenfield's engine to stand-by at their station to cover calls in the city. Greenfield's crew was on stand-by for two hours.

**Friday, March 6**

**Motor Vehicle Accident -- Petrilak Road**

At 12:10 a.m. Greenfield's engine and Greenfield's ambulance along with Clifford rescue and ambulance responded to a motor vehicle accident on Petrilak Road in Greenfield Township for a car into a tree. Chief 24a responded to scene reporting a car into a tree and no one in vehicle. Clifford units were released quickly while Greenfield's crew assisted police and wrecker to remove vehicle.

**Assist to Clifford EMS RR1 Forest City**

At noon Greenfield's ambulance assisted Clifford EMS on a medical emergency on RR1 in Forest City. Greenfield Ambulance transported one patient to a local hospital.

**Car Fire Bell Mountain Road**

At 5:30 p.m. Greenfield's engine, tanker and ambulance responded to a car fire on Bell Mountain Road in Greenfield Township. Greenfield's engine arrived on scene and stretched a 1 ¾ hand line and quickly knocked down fire. Units operated for one hour.
