

Greenfield Township Volunteer Fire Company (GTVFC) Fire/EMS Station 24

Weekly Report

September 14 - 27, 2009

Monday, September 14:

At 9:10 p.m. Greenfield units were dispatched to assist Scott Twp for an activated smoke detector at the Joe Terry Civic Center. Chief 36 arrived and found a tripped detector but no fire. All units were placed back in service within minutes.

At 10:08 a.m. Greenfield Ambulance was dispatched to Allesandra Drive for a medical emergency. Greenfield Ambulance crew and Cottage Paramedics transported a patient to a city hospital. Units cleared in approximately two hours.

Tuesday, September. 22:

At 11:35 a.m. Greenfield Ambulance was requested by Susquehanna County to assist Clifford with a medical emergency in Lennox Township. Greenfield Ambulance and Cottage Paramedics transported a female patient to a city hospital.

Thursday, September 24:

At 1:48 a.m. Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were dispatched to assist Scott Twp on a motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Tompkinsville Road and Country Club Road. No injuries were found and Greenfield units were placed back in service.

Friday, September 25:

At 6 p.m. Greenfield Ambulance went on stand-by for the Lakeland Chiefs football game.

Sunday, September 27:

At 1:20 p.m. Greenfield units responded to Opeil Road for an ATV accident. All units were in service within one hour.

At 6:11 p.m. Greenfield units were dispatched for a possible transformer fire at the PPL substation on Route 106. Chief 24 arrived on scene and found a transformer on fire. Greenfield Fire and Scott Twp PD shut down a portion of Route 106 as a precaution until PPL arrived on scene. PPL arrived in approximately 30 minutes and the scene was turned over to them. All units cleared the scene in approximately two hours.
