Tuesday, October 13

At 1:35 p.m. Greenfield Ambulance was requested by Susquehanna County to assist Clifford Ambulance with a medical emergency on Buffalo Farm Road in West Clifford. Greenfield Ambulance and Cottage Paramedics transported a female to a city hospital. All units cleared within one hour.

At 6:15 p.m. Greenfield Ambulance was dispatched for a medical emergency on Creamery Road in the Township. Greenfield Ambulance and Cottage Paramedics transported a female to a local hospital. Units cleared within one hour and 15 minutes.

Wednesday, October 14
