Sunday, November 8

At 9:27 a.m. Greenfield Ambulance was dispatched for a medical emergency on Creamery Road. Greenfield Ambulance transported a patient to a local hospital. Greenfield Ambulance was back in service within one hour and 15 minutes.

Wednesday, November 11

At 3:55 p.m. Greenfield Engine, Tanker and Ambulance were dispatched to assist Clifford for a fire on Church Street in Clifford. Greenfield units went back in service within one hour.

At 11:16 p.m. Greenfield Station was requested to stand by for Clifford while they worked on a structure fire in Montrose. Greenfield units stood by for four hours.
