Weekly Report

December 6 - 12, 2009

Sunday, December 6

At 2:52 p.m. Greenfield Engine and Ambulance was dispatched for a minor motor vehicle accident on Rt 247 near Petrilak Road with minor injuries. LT 24 A arrived on scene and obtained three patient refusals and all units were placed back in service within 40 minutes.

At 3:04 p.m. Greenfield Ambulance was dispatched to Healey Hill Road for a fall victim. Greenfield Ambulance and Cottage Paramedics transported a patient to a local hospital. All units cleared within one hour.

At 11:28 p.m. Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were dispatched for an activated Carbon Monoxide Detector on James Road. Greenfield firefighters checked the residence with several different meters but found nothing. All units were placed back in service within 40 minutes.

Monday, December 7

At 11:13 a.m. Greenfield Ambulance was dispatched to assist Clifford Fire on a two-car crash on Mudd Road in Clifford. Greenfield Ambulance obtained a refusal from the single patient and was placed back in service within 60 minutes.

At 4:27 p.m. Greenfield Engine was requested by Wayne County to assist Waymart Fire Department on a possible structure fire on Belmont Street in Waymart. All units were cancelled and placed back in service within 30 minutes.

Wednesday, December 9

At 1:50 a.m. Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were dispatched by Susquehanna county to assist Clifford Fire on a two-vehicle accident possibly involving a tractor trailer. All units cleared within 60 minutes.

At 10:24 a.m. Greenfield Engine was dispatched for a tree down on wires on Poor Farm Road. PPL electric utilities were notified to remove the hazard. All units were placed back in service within 60 minutes.

At 8:10 p.m. Greenfield Engine was dispatched for a tree down in the road on Poor Farm Road. Chief 24 arrived and advised that PPL electric utilities was on scene correcting the hazard, all units were placed back in service within one hour and 30 minutes.

At 11:34 p.m. Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were requested by Susquehanna County to assist Clifford Fire on a possible tractor trailer rollover at mile marker 206 Northbound on the Interstate. Greenfield Ambulance stood by and Greenfield Engine provided traffic control at the scene. All units worked on scene for approximately 3.5 hours.

Friday, December 11

At 5:20 p.m. Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were dispatched for a motor vehicle accident where possibly two vehicles struck a deer at mile marker 204.8 North on the Interstate. Chief 24 arrived and advised the call was near the Susquehanna County line. Greenfield Engine and Clifford Rescue controlled traffic while Greenfield Ambulance obtained patient refusals. All units cleared within 60 minutes.

Saturday, December 12

At 11:33 a.m. Greenfield Engine and Ambulance was dispatched for a one-car accident on Dundaff Street. Greenfield units responded but the call was actually in Fell Township. A paramedic from Cottage advised Comm Center that one patient was requesting transport. Greenfield Ambulance stabilized the patient and Cottage Ambulance transported the patient to a local hospital. All units cleared within 60 minutes.
