



## Greenfield Township Volunteer Fire Company (GTVFC) Fire/EMS Station 24

Weekly Report

December 23 - 31, 2009

### December 13

At 4:55 p.m. Greenfield Engine, Tanker and Ambulance were dispatched for a possible car fire on Interstate 81 Mile marker 202 just North of the rest stop. Lieutenant 24A arrived on scene and advised incoming units of a fully involved car fire. Chief 24 requested Clifford Tanker to assist. Units cleared within one hour and 30 minutes.

### December 18

At 7:46 a.m. Greenfield units were dispatched for a possible chimney fire at the Tompkinsville United Methodist Church. Greenfield PD arrived on scene and stated a possible furnace malfunction. Chief 24A arrived and confirmed a malfunctioning furnace and held all units at their stations. All units back in service within 30 minutes.

### December 20

At 11:06 a.m. Greenfield Units assisted Clifford on a motor vehicle accident with multiple injuries on SR 2008 in Clifford, the first of three runs for both departments. Greenfield Engine controlled the traffic pattern around the scene while Greenfield Ambulance transported two patients to a rendezvous point with Forest City EMS, where Forest City EMS took care of one patient. Both patients were transported to the city trauma center.

At 11:30 a.m. the second accident, Greenfield Engine and Ambulance assisted Clifford with the second of three consecutive accidents in Clifford. Incoming units arrived and found a patient with minor injuries from the accident on Route 374 near the Lift Inn. EMS units transported a patient to a local hospital. All units cleared within 30 minutes.

At 11:54 a.m. Greenfield units assisted with the third MVA in Clifford at the intersection of Routes 106 and 374. A patient with minor injuries was transported to a local hospital by Forest City EMS. All units cleared all three accidents within three hours.

At 12:42 p.m. Greenfield Ambulance was dispatched to the city of Carbondale to assist Cottage EMS while all their units were tied up with other emergencies. Greenfield Ambulance responded to Laurel Street but was cancelled as the patient went to the hospital in a private vehicle. All units cleared within 30 minutes.

At 6:35 p.m. Greenfield Ambulance was dispatched to our station to meet a patient there for an unknown medical emergency. Greenfield Ambulance transported a male patient to a local hospital. All units cleared within one hour.

### December 27

At 8:01 p.m. Greenfield Station was dispatched to a possible electrical fire on Route 247 in the township. Chief 24 arrived and found a slight smoke condition. All units continued in for the investigation. Units then cleared within one hour.

### December 29

At 9:59 a.m. Greenfield Ambulance was dispatched to Lee Road for a medical emergency. Greenfield Ambulance and Cottage Paramedics transported a patient to a local hospital. All units cleared within one hour.

### December 31

At 9:09 a.m. Greenfield Engine and Ambulance were dispatched to assist Clifford Fire and EMS at mile marker 206 South for a single car rollover unknown for injuries. Units checked the Interstate to and from Milemarker 211 with negative results. While checking for this accident, Clifford was dispatched to a two vehicle accident on State Route 2067 near Lake Idlewild. Greenfield units were re-routed to that accident. Chief 18-2 marked on scene and established command having Greenfield Engine control the hazards and traffic, while Greenfield Ambulance transported a patient to a city hospital. All units cleared both calls within two hours.

At 9:52 p.m. Greenfield Engine was dispatched to Lincoln Avenue and Laurel Street in Carbondale for an activated fire alarm. No fire was found and Greenfield units were placed back in service within 30 minutes.
