December 30, 2008

Structure Fire at 231 Second Street at Fig Hill Trailer Park

Tuesday night's work session turned into a structure fire response. On Tuesday December 30, at 10:00 p.m., the 24 structure fire box was transmitted for a confirmed working trailer fire at 231 Second Street in Greenfield at the Fig Hill Trailer Park. Lackawanna County dispatcher provided 24 Chief with multiple calls and sounded full 1st alarm.

24 Chief went directly to scene confirming light smoke condition and requested 24 units to continue in, and all other units to stage at current locations. 24 crews contained the fire to a small portion of the kitchen area with some extensions to the wall and floor. 24 crews were on scene for one hour. Two people from the residency were transported to Marian hospital in Carbondale for evaluations.
