Dear Members,

The concept for a museum to document and display our local history came about in 2002. We planned and raised enough money to start the building so that we all could see the progress, rather than waiting for all the money for begin.

Now, over 75% of the museum is complete and paid for, and we are at the point where we can possibly complete the museum in 2012. We will need \$30,000 for completion. At this time, we have 24 family members, 22 individual members, and 66 lifetime members for 112 active members, and 56 inactive members. Our yearly income is approximately \$4,000 from dues, bake sales, etc., and if we apply our yearly income for the next 2 years to the \$30,000, we will need \$22,000, which comes to \$65.50 per member for 2011 and 2012.

Our goal for a 2012 completion can be a reality with your continued support and generosity.

This spring we will be transferring our documents, photographs, pictures, and genealogy to the museum's attic storeroom as a staging area. This will free up our 1850 schoolhouse to be used as an attraction and a teaching tool for schools, instead of a storage area.

Our income, as of December 31, 2010, was \$3774, leaving the Historical Society with a balance of \$3,020.94, with no outstanding debts or bills.

We regret the loss of the following members to death: Merle Goodrich, Corinne Petrilak, Helen Soltis, William Sweet, and Boris Telep.
